Sub: Revised guidelines of ISAPM - Own Source & Bank Finance

The 6th Meeting of the Technical Committee under the Incentive Scheme on Acquisition of Plants& Machinery [ISAPM] was held on 16th March 2016 under the Chairmanship of the Jute Commissioner. Copy of the approved minutes has already been circulated to all and uploaded in the website www.jute.com [under Current Scheme ... Incentive Scheme on Acquisition of Plants& Machinery].

During the discussion, it was felt that the present methodology of sanctioning and releasing subsidy under the Scheme is unnecessarily complex and some steps do not actually add value to the process of scrutiny of claims. It was suggested that a simplified process may be adopted for a quicker disposal of cases while improving accountability.

It was decided to introduce a single-window system by National Jute Board [NJB] in association with Indian Jute Mill Association [IJMA] for receiving complete claim applications in person. IJMA officials will receive and scrutinize the claims applications in their office and get them rectified, if necessary. The same after rectification by IJMA will have to be submitted to NJB in person on every Monday or the next working day if Monday is a holiday. This system is effective from 1st April 2016. The flowcharts depicting the revised guidelines to be followed under funding through Own Source and Bank Finance are enclosed.

It is now requested to kindly circulate to all and implement the system please.




